

Make Sure Schools in Your County Get the Support They Deserve, So Your Students Can Receive a Visit They'll Never Forget.

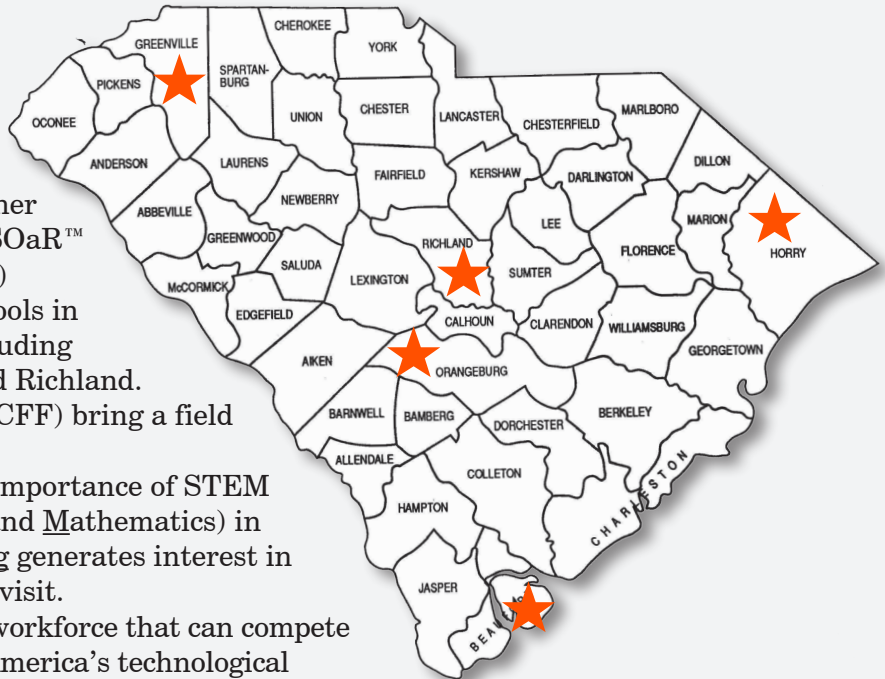
Schools don't always need to plan field trips. In fact, 574 Title 1 schools in South Carolina are eligible to receive federally-funded educational visits.
